

In Short Stirrup Hunter, mounts and riders may not cross enter any other VHSA division but Pleasure and VHSA Eq Flat. All VHSA rules apply.

Long Stirrup, EQ: Open to riders over 12 years of age as of 12/1/23 and adults. Riders may not cross enter any class with jumps over 18". May trot or canter over jumps.

Student Equitation: Open to riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing 2' or higher as of 12/1/23. May trot or canter over fences.

Pleasure: Open to horses/ponies ridden by adults/ juniors. Judged on performance and soundness: emphasis on manners. Section A Ponies with Jr. Riders. Section B Horses will be split Adult/Jr. if entries warrant.

Pony Hunter: Open to Ponies 14.2 hands & under ridden by juniors. Jumps: Small 2'; Medium 2'3"; Large 2'6".

Baby Green Hunter Open to very green horses and ponies in their 1st year of showing at 18' or higher as of 12/1/23. Must trot over fences.

Maiden Hunter: Open to Horses or Ponies in their first year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of 12/1/23. May trot or canter over fences.

Green Pony Hunter: Open to Horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 2'6" or higher and Ponies in their 1st year of showing at 2', 2'3", 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/23. Will be split if entries warrant.

Ponies: no restriction on riders. To be run Low at 2', 2'3"Schooling at 2'6"

OFFICE FEE: A \$15.00 Office Fee will be charged per horse/pony and rider combination.

ENTRY FEES: Hunters: \$25.00 per class pre-entry, \$30.00 post-entry. Jumpers: classes 1–22 \$25.00 pre-entry, \$30.00 post-entry; classes 23–31 \$30.00 pre-entry, \$35.00 post-entry For pre-entries email to: thewinslettadvantage@gmail.com, or horseshowsonline.com VHSA medal classes \$30 pre-entry, \$35 post-entry

There will be a \$25 penalty fee per horse/pony/rider for failure to close out your check at the conclusion of your showing

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS: Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and regulations of the current BHSA and VHSA rule books, will be conducted and judged accordingly. The judge's decision is always final.**COGGINS TEST:** All exhibitors must present a negative Coggins Test report taken within one year on each animal exhibited. This is a Virginia State Law. *Please bring an extra copy to leave with your entry.*

SCHOOLING: Will be permitted only in designated schooling areas. Hunter schooling available from 7:00 AM to 8:45 AM, Jumper schooling available from 8:00 AM to 9:15 AM prior to the show and as listed in the Time Schedule.

ATTIRE: All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI protective helmets with harness fastened at all times while mounted on the show grounds. Boots and breeches/jodhpurs requested. Winter jackets and full chaps allowed. Half chaps with paddock boots and breeches allowed. No jeans.

UNJUDGED ROUNDS: Will be allowed at the end of the classes, or as breaks occur, at regular-entry fee.

AWARDS: Six ribbons per class. Champion Trophy and Ribbon and Reserve Champion Trophy and Ribbon in each division. Points scored 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, ½ plus bonus points as given in the VHSA/BHSA rules for show championships.

GRAND CHAMPIONS: Trophies awarded to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions at last show of season in each division based on total points won in all shows. Winners must have shown in at least 2 Hunter/2 Jumper shows to be eligible and must be present at the final show to receive the award.

GROUNDS FEE: \$15/Horse/Pony for any not taking a stall.

STALLS: \$45.00 per night/day. Bedding not included. Bedding available.
