WELCOME TO THE 2023 VHSA ASSOCIATES' CHAMPIONSHIP HORSE SHOW

Welcome to the 31st Virginia Horse Shows Association Associates' Championship Horse Show. Throughout the year, participating local shows across the state were recognized as VHSA Associate Shows, allowing their exhibitors to accumulate points toward special Associate High Score Awards. Participants in the Associates' Program must be a Member of the VHSA, and their horses must be recorded with the VHSA. The top ten horse show scores will be used to determine the Associate High Score Award in each division. The Associates' Championship Show will be a "Bonus Show" and gives participants additional points. Points awarded at the Championship show will be through sixth place 20, 12, 8, 4, 2, 1 with champion receiving an additional 10 and reserve 6. In order to participate in the VHSA Associate Championship Horse Show, horses and rider must have participated in at least five Associate Member Shows as recorded members and the qualifying horse shows for each must be listed on the entry form. Exhibitors may show in any division they choose at the Championship Show, regardless of the divisions they showed in to qualify. ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED IN ALL DIVISIONS. The top twenty horses in each division will be automatically allowed to compete, provided that their entries have been postmarked by the closing date. All other entries will be accepted in order of their postmarks. The closing date of entries is October 26, 2023.

Entries postmarked after that date will be put on a waiting list.

The Capital Challenge

Each Association and/or Show Series can submit a team to represent one Association and/or Show Series. The team shall consist of a maximum of five members or may be less than five. The teams shall be composed of five or less of the following: 1) One small/medium pony and rider. 2) One large pony and rider. 3) One children's hunter and rider. 4) One adult hunter and rider. 5) One green or open hunter and rider. 6) One green pony and rider.

Rules:

- 1. An animal or rider may only represent one Association and/or Show Series.
- 2. There may be only one professional on each team.
- 3. One substitution can be made on each team. Example: If no small/medium pony is available a substitution may be made by adding a second animal in any division.
- 4. The Team Competition will take place on Thursday and Saturday and will include all of the Jumping classes. Team points will be awarded according to individual placings.
- 5. No Association and/or Show Series may have more than one team.
- 6. A condition of competing is the 2023 winner has to supply the trophy for 2024.
- 7. This is strictly for fun!!

- 1. The VHSA Associates' Championship Horse Show is operated in accordance with the rules of the Virginia Horse Shows Association's Associate Program.
- 2. The VHSA, the Virginia Horse Center, Officials and employees will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which occur to any exhibitor, spectator, groom, animal, or equipment at the show.
- 3. CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES IS October 26, 2023.
- 4. Stalls are available at a cost of \$150 for the show (<u>No Stall Splits Allowed</u>). Bedding is available for purchase on the grounds. All bedding orders must be placed with the Virginia Horse Center Stable Office - (540) 464-2966.
- 5. ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR APPROVED PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR ANY TIME WHEN MOUNTED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- 6. All dogs must be on leashes and no dogs are allowed in the East Complex or Coliseum
- 7. A dotted line may be used in all classes should entries warrant.
- 8. All horses must have a current coggins test certificate, and a current legible copy must be submitted with your entries.
- 9. We reserve the right to refuse any entry, to ban any person or animal from the show grounds, to change the time schedule, to combine classes or change the judge at any time.
- 10. Horse Show management's decisions concerning any aspect of the horse show will be final.

~ A NOTE TO THE EXHIBITORS ~

Welcome to the 31st VHSA Associate Championship Horse Show. We are once again going with a four full day schedule in order to try and shorten and possibly eliminate some of the conflicts on day two. We still expect some conflicts during the show and expect the trainers/riders and starters to work them out. This show will again feature the \$1,000 Hunter classic, check the class specification for details.

All jumping classes will have posted orders and schooling schedules have been adjusted. Please take note of the changes and come prepared. We know trainer/rider conflicts occur, however, it is up to the trainer/rider to check the schedule/jump orders and to work out their conflicts with the starters. We can not hold up the rings for anyone, so come prepared to handle the distance between the two rings and bring extra help if you need it.

If you are not in possession of a current Coggins Test Certificate for your horse, it will not be admitted to the show grounds per current Virginia State Law.

Be sure to submit a copy of your current coggins test with your Entries.

Virginia Horse Center Visitor Policies

- 1. Upon arrival at the Virginia Horse Center, all trailers must check in at the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
- 2. A negative Coggins must be provided for every horse brought onto the grounds and turned into the Stable Office (state law). Horses coming from out of state are required to have a health certificate (federal law).
- 3. No smoking in Coliseum or Barns. This is the law.
- 4. Vehicles: Drive Carefully. Obey All Traffic Signs. Speed limits are strictly enforced. Every vehicle operator must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance. The use of vehicles in the camping areas is restricted to regular roadways for entering and exiting only. Vehicles are permitted only if operated in a safe manner (this is a Virginia state law), but may not be used in the Coliseum or in the interior of any of the barns. Four wheelers and ATV's are not permitted on the VHC grounds. Non-powered scooters, bicycles, skateboards, in-line skates, heelers (skates in shoes) are not permitted in the Coliseum or the interior of any of the barns. The VHC reserves the right to prohibit the operation of any vehicle.
- 5. Dogs/Pets: All dogs/pets must have current inoculations for rabies as prescribed by state of residency. No loose dogs/pets are allowed anywhere on the premises. All dogs/pets that are not crated must be on a hand-held or tied leash. Loose dogs/pets will incur a \$100 fine. You must clean up after your dog/pet. No dogs/pets allowed in the Coliseum unless they are crated or are Service Dogs. No dogs/pets in the Mezzanine (2nd floor of the Coliseum) under any circumstances with the exception of Service Dogs. We ask that your Service Dog have his or her vest on.
- 6. Grounds/Parking Areas/Barns/East Complex: All dogs/pets must be on a hand-held or tied leash.
- 7. No trash or sharps in the manure pits. Sharps should be placed in red boxes in barns.
- 8. All stalls must have at least one bale of shavings or straw. Sawdust is prohibited. Shavings may be purchased at the Welcome Center (Stable Office). (No Stall Splits Allowed)
- 9. No lunging in Wiley, Northern, B Ring, the Coliseum and the East Complex.
- 10. No overnight horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out.
- 11. Horses are not allowed to be ponied behind any moving vehicles.
- 12. No vehicles allowed in the barns.
- 13. Campers must register at Stable Office/Welcome Center.
- 14. Check-In time and Check-Out time subject to show date.
- 15. No gray water is to be dumped on the ground. Sewage arrangements are made through the Stable Office/Welcome Center.
- 16. Campfires are not permitted.
- 17. Campers must keep their sites clean and dispose of refuse in the receptacles provided. All campers will be responsible for leaving the campsite as they found it. Any damage or repairs resulting from negligence shall be the responsibility of the camper.
- 18. All central service buildings and other facilities in the campground are for campers' and exhibitors' use only.
- 19. Firearms and fireworks are not permitted.
- 20. No tent, camper, RV or camping equipment shall be left unattended longer than 24 hours without written permission from campground management.
- 21. Any loss, theft, accident or disturbance should be reported to the Virginia Horse Center Security. Lost and Found is located in the Security Office.
- 22. Virginia Horse Center management reserves the right to remove from the premises any camper or visitor who is in violation of these rules and regulations.
- 23. The Virginia Horse Center shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by camper arising or resulting in any respect from camper's occupancy and use of premises, and/or visitor and visitor's use of premises.
