

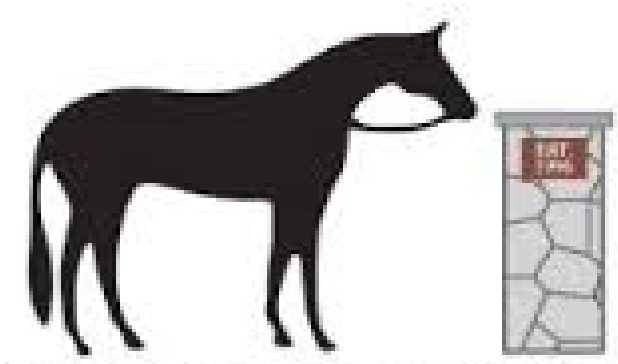
Fees are as follows:

- ❖ Entry Fees: \$50 per division, \$25 Equitation or per class, \$20 un-judged warm-up (\$25 fee for returned checks)
- ❖ Office Fee: \$12 per entry
- ❖ Registration Fee of \$50 to become a member of the Winter Series to accrue points. You must be a member before the show starts to accrue points.
- ❖ Stalls: \$30 including bedding
- ❖ \$10 late fee for the following: all phone entries, entries with no Coggins or entries received after Thursday before the show.
- ❖ **Lease and Coaching fees are in addition to entry fees for Stonehouse Stables riders.**

Rules and Regulations:

1. Stonehouse Stables, Inc. will not be responsible for any accident, injury, or loss of property on the grounds before, during, or after any event.
2. No stallions allowed on show grounds.
3. Stonehouse Stables reserves the right to refuse any entry, to change the time schedule, to combine classes, or change judges at any time.
4. Any entry that schools but does not show will be charged a \$25.00 schooling fee.
5. Points and ribbons will be awarded for 1st – 6th in each class and Champion and Reserve will be awarded in each division. Points will follow VHSA rules.
6. Points will count, with membership, towards Winter Series Awards. An awards ceremony will be held at the end of the series.
7. ASTM approved hard hats must always be worn by juniors and adults while mounted.
8. Dogs are not encouraged at the show. Dogs not on leashes and barking dogs may be asked to leave.
9. Stalls are limited and will be given out by management only.
10. Schooling is available two hours prior to the start of the show, weather permitting.
11. Junior riders – any rider under 18 years old as of Dec. 1, 2021.
12. Adults may ride ponies.

Working Hunter: Open to Juniors, Amateurs, and Professionals on horses or ponies to jump 2'6", 2'9", or 3'. To be judged on performance of the horse. **Sponsored by Henderson Inc.**

VHSA Equitation on the Flat: A flat class to be judged on the rider's position and performance. Tests 1-9 may be performed at the judges' discretion.

Junior Equitation: Fences at 2'6, 2'9 or 3'. Selected riders may be asked to return for testing or hacking at the judges' discretion. No cross-entering between this and Pony Equitation at the same show. **Sponsored by The New York Deli.**

Children's Hunter: Open only to junior riders on horses. Fences are 2'6, 2'9, or 3'. To be judged on performance of the horse. **Sponsored by Lakeside Concrete Enterprises.**

Adult Amateur Hunter: Open only to adult amateur riders on horses. Fences are 2'6, 2'9, or 3'. To be judged on performance of the horse. **Sponsored by The Structures Group Inc.**

Adult Equitation: Fences at 2'6, 2'9 or 3'. Selected riders may be asked to return for testing or hacking at the judges' discretion. **Sponsored by Tidewater Equine Clinic.**

Pony Hunter: Open to juniors on ponies. Fences are 2' for smalls, 2'3 for mediums and 2'6 or 2'9 for larges.- **Sponsored by Crow's Garage.**

Pony Equitation: Fences at 2' for smalls, 2'3 for mediums or 2'6 for larges. Riders may be asked to return for testing or hacking at the judges' discretion. No cross-entering between this and Junior Equitation at the same show.

Lead Line: Riders are escorted by a lead. Judged on turnout and position. Riders may not cross-enter.

Pony Pleasure: Open to juniors on ponies. To be judged on the ponies' movement, disposition, and way of going pleurably.

Pre-Short/Long Stirrup Equitation: Open to Juniors who have not shown at the canter/over fences. To show at a walk and trot in various positions and trot a course of poles. Rider's must be under 18 as of December 1st, 2021. **Sponsored by TPMG West Point Family Medicine.**

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 13th birthday as of December 1st, 2021. Judged as a hunter division. Riders may only cross enter in Short Stirrup Equitation and Pleasure.- **Sponsored by Two Drummers Smokehouse.**

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to juniors who have not yet reached their 13th birthday as of December 1st, 2021. A single course judged on equitation. Riders may only cross enter in Short Stirrup Hunter and Pleasure

Special Hunter: Open to horses and ponies. Open to all riders and horse/pony combinations. Fences are 2'. **Sponsored by Woodside Equine Clinic.**

Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter: Open to children or adult amateurs on horses. Horse/rider combinations may not cross-enter any ring 1 divisions except Equitation on the flat.- **Sponsored by Peter R. Krantz, Jr., MBA, CLU New York Life Insurance Company.**

Horse Pleasure: Open to Adults and Juniors; but may split if entries warrant. To be judged on the horse's movement, disposition, and way of going pleurably. **Sponsored by Lakewood Trails.**
