## Class/Division Specifications

**Leadline**-(BHSA) Open to riders 7 years of age & under as of Dec 1<sup>st</sup> of current show year. Riders may not cross into any class where they will be asked to trot.

**Pre-Short Stirrup**- (BHSA) Open to riders 10 years of age & under, may not cross enter any class that canters or jumps.

**Short Stirrup Equitation**-(BHSA) Open to riders 12 years of age & under. Riders not allowed to cross enter classes where they would jump over 18".

**Short Stirrup Hunter**-(VHSA) Open to riders 12 years of age & under. May not cross enter another VHSA division, except pleasure & eq flat.

**Pleasure Pony**-Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Judged on performance & soundness with emphasis on manners & suitability.

**Pleasure Horse**-Open to horses ridden by juniors or adults. Judged on performance & soundness with emphasis on manners & suitability.

**Pony Hunter**-Open to ponies not exceeding 14.2 Hands, ridden by juniors. Smalls 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'6"

**Maiden Hunter**- Open to horses & ponies in their first year of showing over 2' or higher. No restrictions on riders.

**Low/Schooling**: Open to horses & ponies. No rider restrictions. Low Hunter to jump 2', Schooling Hunter to jump 2'6".

**Limit Hunter Rider**: Open to horses and ponies ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateurs who are not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher. An Adult Amateur can ride a pony if the pony is not competing in a pony class or division. These riders are not eligible for AA Equitation, Pony Equitation, or Jr./Children's Equitation over fences. Horses and ponies may cross enter other divisions. Courses to be a minimum of 6 fences set at 2' or 2'3". Can be combined only with Low Hunter and/or Maiden Hunter. If combined, it is the Show Secretary's responsibility to indicate which is the Limit Rider Hunter, which is the Low Hunter and which is the Maiden Hunter.

**Student Equitation**: Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2' or higher as of December 1 of the current show year. Jumps to be a minimum of 2'. Riders competing in the Student Equitation Division are limited to two years only, whether they compete over fences or not. To be judged as an equitation division. Points go to the rider. Courses may be trotted.

**Children's/Adult**- Open to junior or adult amateurs on horses. Fences 2'6" or 3'.

**Green Hunter**: Open to horses in their first or second year of showing at 2'6".

**TB Hunter**-Open to registered TB & horses eligible to be registered. Fences 2'6".

**Working Hunter**-Open to all riders & horses. Fences 3' or 3'3"

**VHSA Adult Amateur Medal**- Open to horses only. Rider must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3. and must hold a current amateur card issued by USEF. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at three (3) feet, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. All VHSA Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long ride to a single jump. Riders may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3 feet, 3 inches (1.0m) with the exception of the Childrens/Adult Jumper division, at the same show, where a rider may not jump higher than 3'9" (1.15m). This also applies to the show hosting the VHSA Adult/Children's Hunter Medal Finals. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing over fences.. Jumping faults of mount not to count. Fall of horse or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. There must be at least three (3) exhibitors to fill the class and three (3) exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. This Class can be combined with the VHSA Children's Medal. In the Finals, same testing applies.

**VHSA Children's Medal Class**- Open to Junior members of VHSA who have not reached their 18th birthday. Riders may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3 feet, 3 inches (1.0m) with the exception of the Childrens/Adult Jumper division, at the same show, where a rider may not jump higher than 3'9" (1.15m). Rider must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3. Open to horses only. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at three (3) feet, which must include one combination and two changes of direction. All VHSA Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long

ride to a single jump. This also applies to the show hosting the VHSA Adult/Children's Hunter Medal Finals. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing over fences. Fall of horse or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. There must be at least three (3) exhibitors to fill the class and three (3) exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. This Medal can be combined with the VHSA Adult Medal. In the Finals, same testing applies.

## Rules

1. Six ribbons awarded in each class. Champion & Reserve Champion Ribbons & Prizes.
2. The judge's decision is final.
3. Points awarded per associate rules & regulations.
4. Approved Hats (ASTM/SEI) required at all times when mounted.
5. The show manager has the right to split, combine, or cancel any division.
6. A copy of negative coggins within 12 months must be submitted in order to show.
7. All dogs must be on a leash.
8. A \$50 fee for all returned checks.
9. All classes are governed by the rules/specifications set by the VHSA/BHSA/SWVHJA rule books. The show manager, Orange County Fair any officials, employees, or board of directors, will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, groom, or animal on the show grounds. Participants & spectators understand that horse are inherently unpredictable, dangerous; yet individuals knowingly choose to participate and/or spectate, taking total responsibility for the decision. Entry into the showgrounds constitutes knowledge & agreement with this policy.
