Novice Jumpers: Open to horses and ponies in their 1st and 2nd year showing as Jumpers at 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/21. No cross entry with classes 23-28.

Novice Children's Adult Amateur Jumpers: Open to horses and ponies ridden by children and adult amateurs showing in their 1st and 2nd year of showing jumpers at 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/21. No cross entry with classes 23-28.

Limit Jumpers: Open to riders, horses and ponies not jumping higher than 2'6".

Jr/AA Jumper Equitation: Open to Juniors & Adult Amateur.

Low Jumpers: Open to horses and ponies.

TB Jumper: Open to Thoroughbreds registered with the Jockey Club or eligible to be registered.

Children's /Adult Amateur Jumper: Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies.

Schooling Modified Jumpers: No restrictions on horses/ponies or riders.

Short Stirrup EQ and Hunter Open to riders 12 years and younger as of 12/1/21 on ponies/horses. Riders may not cross enter into any classes which jump over 18". May trot or canter over fences in Short Stirrup Hunter. Mounts may not cross enter into any other VHSA division but Pleasure. All VHSA rules apply for Hunter, BHSA rules apply for Equitation.

Student Equitation Open to riders in their 1st and 2nd year of showing 2' or higher as of 12/1/2021. May trot or canter over fences.

Pleasure Open to horses/ponies ridden by Adults/Juniors. Judged on performance and soundness: Emphasis on manners and suitability. Section A ponies with Jr riders. Section B horses with split Adult/Junior if entries warrant.

Pony Hunter Open to ponies 14.2 hands & under. Ridden by Juniors. Jumps: Small 2', Mediums 2'3", Large 2'6"

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation – Open to riders 10 years and under as of 12/1/21. Riders may not cross enter into any classes where they would be asked to canter or jump.

Baby Green Hunter Open to very green horses and ponies in their 1st year of showing at 18' or higher as of 12/1/2021. Must trot over fences.

Maiden Hunter Open to horses and ponies in their 1st year of showing 2' or higher as of 12/1/2021. May trot or canter over fences.

Green Hunter Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 2'6' or higher and ponies in their 1st year of showing over fences 2', 2'3", 2'6" or higher as of 12/1/2021. Will be split if entries warrant.

Low, Schooling Hunter Open to all horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. To run Low at 2', 2'3" Schooling at 2'6".

Children's/Adult Amateur Hunter Open to horses ridden by Juniors and Adult Amateur Hunter Open to horses or ponies not being ridden in Pony Division ridden by Adult Amateurs. Will be split if entries warrant.

TB Hunter Open to Thoroughbreds registered with the Jockey Club or eligible to be registered.

Working Hunter Open to all horses and ponies not showing in any pony divisions.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

OFFICE FEE: A \$10.00 Office Fee will be charged per horse/pony and rider combination.

ENTRY FEES: Hunters: \$20.00 per class pre-entry, \$22.00 post-entry. Jumpers: classes 1–19 \$22.00 pre-entry, \$25.00 post-entry; classes 20–28 \$27.00 pre-entry, \$30.00 post-entry. \$5 of each entry fee is donated to the prize money. For pre-entries email to: thewinslettadvantage@gmail.com or TWAhorseshows.yolasite.com Fax to (call first) 540-972-1342.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS: Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and regulations of the current BHSA and VHSA rule books, will be conducted and judged accordingly. The judge's decision is always final.

COGGINS TEST: All exhibitors must present a negative Coggins Test report taken within one year on each animal exhibited. This is a Virginia State Law. ***Please bring an extra hard copy to leave with the show secretary for each horse show. Coggins will not be kept on file.***

SCHOOLING: Will be permitted only in designated schooling areas. Hunter schooling available from 7:00AM to 8:45AM, Jumper schooling available from 8:00AM to 9:15AM prior to the show and as listed in the Time Schedule.

ATTIRE: All exhibitors must wear ASTM/SEI protective helmets with harness always fastened while mounted on the show grounds. Boots and breeches/jodhpurs requested. Winter jackets and full chaps allowed. Half chaps with paddock boots and breeches allowed. No jeans.

UNJUDGED ROUNDS: Will be allowed at the end of the classes, or as breaks occur, at regular-entry fee.

AWARDS: Six ribbons per class. Champion Trophy and Ribbon and Reserve Champion Trophy and Ribbon in each division. Points scored 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, ½ plus bonus points as given in the VHSA/BHSA rules for show championships.

GRAND CHAMPIONS: Trophies awarded to Grand Champions and Reserve Grand Champions at last show of season in each division based on total points won in all shows. Winners must have shown in at least 2 Hunter/2 Jumper shows to be eligible and must be present at the final show to receive the award.

STALLS: \$45.00 per night/day. Bedding not included. Bedding available.

GROUNDS FEE: \$15/Horse/Pony for any not taking a stall.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The Winslett Advantage, Fairfax County Park Authority, Frying Pan Farm Park, and the Founders, Benefactors, Supervisors and Friends of Frying Pan Farm Park, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, rider, guest, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. Any equine activity, sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. This is in accordance with the Virginia Equine Activity Liability Act 3.2-6200 thru 3.2-6203 of the Code of Virginia (as amended), which states the inherent risks in equine activities

DIRECTIONS

Frying Pan Farm Park 2739 West Ox Road, Herndon, VA 20171

From I66-66 East: Take Exit 53, Rt 28 North, Sully Road towards Dulles Airport. Exit at McLearen Road East. At Rt 657 Centerville Road, turn left. Go to the first traffic light and turn right on West Ox Road, Rt 608. Frying Pan Farm Park is on the left about ¼ mile.

From U.S. 50 East: Take exit to Rt. 28, Sully Road North and follow above directions.

From Culpeper, Warrenton: Take U.S. 29 North to I-66, follow above directions.

From I-95 North: At Falmouth, Rt 17, take exit towards Warrenton. At Opal take Rt 29 North to I-66, follow above directions.

Alternative #1 from I-95 North: Take Exit 152B onto Rt. 234 Dumfries Road, North or West to I-66, follow the above directions.

Alternative #2 from I-95 North: Take Exit 160B onto Rt. 123. Continue to Rt. 286, Fairfax County Parkway, Go West several miles to West Ox Road, Rt 608, Turn left, go about 1-2 miles to Frying Pan Farm Park, second entrance ,2709, on right.

From Route 7 and the Dulles Greenway: Take Rt. 28 South, Exit at Frying Pan Road, At second light, Rt. 657 Centerville Road, turn right. Go to next light, Rt. 608 West Ox Road and turn left. Frying Pan Park ¼ mile on left.
